REGULATION OF THE CIVIL AVIATION BOARD

NO. 99

RE.: GRANTING LICENSING TO CIVIL AVIATION BUSINESS:
COMMERCIAL AIR TRANSPORT AND AERIAL WORK, with Amendment (No.2)

In order to promote a civil aviation operator engaging in non-scheduled commercial air transport who is required to apply for a new Air Operating License due to error or mistake in an application process and which does not affect safety for continuing its operation by utilizing existing aircraft with continuing airworthiness,

By virtue of Section 15 (6) and Section 41/125 of the Air Navigation Act B.E. 2497 (1954), as amended by the Air Navigation Act (No. 14) B.E. 2562 (2019), the Civil Aviation Board issues the regulation as follows:

Clause 1 This Regulation shall be cited as “Regulation of the Civil Aviation Board No.99, Re.: Granting Licensing to Civil Aviation Business: Commercial Air Transport and Aerial Work, with Amendment (No.2).”

Clause 2 This Regulation shall come into force from the date of its publication in the Government Gazette onwards.

Clause 3 The following provision shall be added to be the second paragraph of Clause 53 of the Regulation of the Civil Aviation Board No.99, Re.: Granting Licensing to Civil Aviation Business: Commercial Air Transport and Aerial Work:

“In a case in which an applicant was a holder of the Air Operating License but who did not apply for a renewal of such License within the specified timeframe and is required to apply for a new Air Operating License under Clause 42, paragraph 3, when it appears to the Director General that such a renewal application delayed because of error or mistake in calculating the duration for its submission, which does not affect aircraft safety, the Director General may propose to the Civil Aviation Board to consider the exemption for the age of the applicant’s aircraft. In such case, the applicant shall be exempted to utilize its existing aircraft qualified to have continuing airworthiness, on the case-by-case basis.
