<p>Note :</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Runway 03/21 remain closed daily during 1501-2259 UTC until 26 DEC 24 due to the surface maintenance and construction of extended apron. 2) All flights are not accepted during 1500 - 2300 UTC (2200 - 0600LT.) 3) All delayed flights shall not be granted to operate during 1500 - 2300 UTC (2200 - 0600 LT.) 4) Due to safety reasons, all departure scheduled are not accepted after 1445 UTC (2145 LT.) 5) The aircraft ground time shall not exceed 4 hours for non-scheduled flights. 6) Due to parking congestion, GA/BA aircraft and overnight parking aircraft shall comply with the CEI parking permission rules and regulations. Parking Permission Rules and Regulations for Aircraft at Mae Fah Luang - Chiang Rai International Airport

According to the Notification of the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand Re: Determination of level of airport congestion of Level 2 Airport and Level 3 Airport B.E. 2562 (2019), Mae Fah Luang - Chiang Rai International Airport (CEI) is designated as a Level 2 Airport, where there is potentiality for congestion during some periods of the day, week, or season which can be resolved by schedule adjustments mutually agreed between the airlines and facilitator. Thus, it is necessary for CEI to set standards, rules, and regulations for overnight aircraft parking, as follows:

1. Air Operator or Handling Agent shall inform aircraft information and flight details to General Manager of Mae Fah Luang - Chiang Rai International Airport by letter and to CEI Airside Operation Division by email.
(CEI Airside Operation Division E-mail: aoc.vtct@airportthai.co.th and flt.vtct@airportthai.co.th)
2. Air Operator or Handling Agent shall coordinate with CEI Airside Operation Division in advance for a parking stand before requesting a slot.
(CEI Airside Operation Division Number: 0 5379 8169 or 0 5379 8164)
3. GA/BA aircraft for overnight parking at CEI will be allocated without affecting the allocation of scheduled flights.
4. Air Operator or Handling Agent shall provide sufficient ground service equipment and be ready to move the aircraft to other stands when requested by CEI.
5. All aircraft shall prepare their own tow bars.
6. Nose-in parking is applicable to all aircraft.
7. In case of flight cancelation or any information changed, Air Operator or Handling Agent shall inform CEI prior to the date of the facilitated Schedule.
